- 7. Self-motivated, organized, and able to fulfill responsibilities in a timely manner.

## Primary Goals of the Position:

- 1. To build up and equip people to be leaders in the church.

This will continue until we all come to such unity in our faith and knowledge of God's Son that we will be mature in the Lord, measuring up to the full and complete standard of Christ.

## Position Responsibilities Overview

3. To lead and direct our congregation's ministry to/for adults from post-high school through their senior years. This includes both those already within the church and those in the community not connected to the church.

## Job Responsibilities Overview

#### **Leadership Development**

- Recruit and lead ministry teams of 3-5 people to help administer the ministry
- Recruit and train small group leaders, teachers, and others as necessary for the ministry
- Meet with group leaders and teachers for feedback and planning
- Oversee the ongoing development of lay visitors
- Keep a timely list of people and their giftedness as it relates to adult ministries

## **Discipleship & Service**

- Be a "bridge" from our church to the community/culture outside of the church
- Develop and foster relationships with people outside of this church
- Pray for those under your spiritual care
- Work into the overall ministry strategy opportunities for adults to:
  - Develop their faith
  - Express/live out their faith
- Work with a team to provide ongoing opportunities for service, outreach, and mission to those outside of our congregation.
- Oversee programming for people in the larger community (eg., divorce recovery, etc.)
- New member orientation
- College and young adults

### **Congregational Care**

• Develop and oversee ministry to the aging members of our congregation. This would include our lay visitation ministries.

#### Management / Administrative

- Set goals, objectives, and strategies which are in line with the mission and vision of the church
- Participate in weekly staff meetings
- Meet with lead pastor for purposes of planning and review
- Develop and submit annual budgets
- Maintain and develop policies as necessary to this area of ministry
- Work 40-50 hours each week
- Take full vacation
- Attend at least one continuing education course each year
- Engage in ongoing professional development
