# **Opportunities to Give**

Little Food Pantry- Drop off in the Red Box outside of the nursery/ preschool rooms, or in the office. Take what you need and add as you are able.

St. Mary's Food Pantry- This past September, St. Mary's helped 163 families, and 456 individual persons. 174 of those individual people were children. The Pantry also provides toiletries and utility assistance with shut off notices. The needs is great and growing greater by the day, but know that by donating food and supporting St. Mary's, we impact the lives of those in need. Current needs:

Peanut butter, ravioli, cereals for kids, mashed potatoes, eggs and cake kits for families to celebrate birthdays together.

Share the Warmth- Donations of goods as well as volunteers are needed. Top needs are disinfectant, toilet paper, paper towels, tissues, printer paper, eggs, whole milk, breakfast bars, coffee, sugar, creamer, non-perishable food items, cereal, bottled paper, frozen meat, Advil/ Tylenol, cold/flu meds, blankets, pillows, twin sheet sheets, and bath towels/ washcloths. Pickleball & Pillowcases- "This is a program started right here at FUMC 6 years ago. It came about by accident. my friend who works for the health department received a donation of pillows, I suggested I make some pillowcases for them. The pillows would be handed out during Project Connect, a yearly program that provides resources for low income and homeless adults in Lenawee County. The pillowcases are made mostly here at church by our wonderful sewing group. We are running very low on fabric. We are holding a fabric drive, there is a donation box located in the lobby by the offices. 1 yard of fabric makes one pillowcase, we accept new material or extra you may have in your stash. It should be 100% cotton and this is an adult

program, men and women. We will not turn away Children's fabric but this is a adult program. Monetary donations can be given as well. Thank you so much for your continued support."
