Fishes & Loaves Food Pantry— We are seeking helpers for this new ministry of Adrian First. We need help with food items provided, stocking shelves, greeting clients, helping to bag food for clients. Please let the office know of your interest.

**Little Food Pantry-** Drop off in the Red Box outside of the nursery/ preschool rooms, or in the office. Take what you need and add as you are able.

St. Mary's Food Pantry- Please continue to bring cereal, eggs and cake kits for families to celebrate birthdays together. Also, we need clean plastic bags and egg cartons. Thanks for your continued support and generosity as the need is greater every day. In April, we served 150 families consisting of 436 individuals, among them 160 children. 22 new families came to our door asking for food.

Top needs are disinfectant, toilet paper, paper towels, tissues, printer paper, eggs, whole milk, breakfast bars, coffee, sugar, creamer, nonperishable food items, cereal, bottled paper, frozen meat, Advil/Tylenol, cold/flu meds, blankets, pillows, twin sheet sheets, and bath towels/washcloths.
