Food Ministries at Adrian First

Over the past five years, Adrian First has had a growing Food Ministry that provides cooked meals for a variety of different groups and raw food products for those with food insecurities. These are our Food Ministry programs offered in 2025 in the order they were started at Adrian First.

Homebound Frozen Meal Program – we produce frozen meals for our homebound parishioners, as well as some people referred to us by other care organizations in the area and then deliver them to their homes. When we started the W.O.W. meals, we added the delivery of a complete hot meal once a month in addition to the freezer meals provided. The Quiche Project was begun to help fund this program so it would not impact on the church's general budget.

W.O.W. Dinner – we hold a fellowship dinner experience every Wednesday at 5:30pm in Fellowship Hall that includes an entrée, starch, vegetable, salad, dessert and beverage for \$7.00 per person. Leftovers from these meals are used to produce freezer meals, as well as occasionally providing food to the Catherine Cobb Domestic Violence Center residents.

Share the Warmth Monthly Meals – Adrian First supplies two meals for 70 people twice a month. One of the monthly meals is coordinated with the W.O.W. Dinner and the other is produced exclusively for the residents of the Share the Warmth shelter

Migrant Farm Worker Meal – joining with St. Mary's Church, Adrian First provides one meal per month during the late summer and fall for approximately 75 migrant workers as a part of our out-reach program.

Missionary Fund Raising Event: November 2nd, United Women of Faith and the Outreach Team are hosting a brunch after church. We will be accepting donations to support missionary Princess M Jusu. She is serving in Liberia as an instructor at the United Methodist Women's Leadership Training Center. Here she teaches skills such as tailoring, tie-dying, how to knit, and home economics to women and girls who have dropped out of school for various reasons. Please join us for a delicious brunch and help support her important mission.

Broadway Book Club Youth Edition: Around the World with Cinderella: Today November 2nd, at 2:30pm, in Farver's at the Croswell. Featuring a fairytale snack table, everyone will enjoy this fun afternoon! We'll hear two Cinderella stories from around the world, plus welcome a special guest reader from the Croswell's cast of Cinderella. Every child who attends will get a new book to take home! Tickets are \$15 per person.

Cinderella Family Night: We have sold out all of our tickets for the matinee performance of Cinderella on November 22nd at 2:30pm!

United Women In Faith Holiday Fundraiser: The annual United Women of Faith Holiday Auction will

be held Monday, November 17th in the Fellowship Hall. This will be a Silent Auction, Live Auction and Buy It Now items. Funds raised will be donated to support Adrian Community Preschool.
